



WELCOME ! WE HOPE YOU HAVE FUN, AND PLEASE REMEMBER, TONIGHT'S ACTIVITIES ARE ABOUT SHOWING OFF AND FAIR COMPETITION. DON'T TAKE THINGS TOO SERIOUSLY! THE FOLLOWING RULES WILL HELP ANSWER YOUR QUESTIONS ABOUT TONIGHT'S ACTIVITIES.

HOW TO ENTER THE PIT AREA & BRACKET ENTRY:

1. Bring your car to the Speedway's pit gate. There are 4 access lanes to enter into the pit. Please go to the shortest one.
2. To enter the Pits (A Restricted Area), you must sign the waiver and release. The waiver and release is at the Pit Gate admission windows. Get out of your car, sign in, and pay for your pit admission into the restricted area.
3. A Tech Inspector will look at your car in the access line. Let them know what Bracket or Brackets you would like to participate in. They will accept the car registration fee(s) at your car. There is a fee for each Bracket you enter.
4. Have fun and be aware for your own safety at all times.
5. Please remember, the Go-Karts typically race the same time we do. They are pitting around our pit entrance area. **Please drive slowly** on the way in and on your way out, as there are many children in this area.

WHERE TO GO IN THE PITS:

1. When entering through the pit gate, look for the Speedway traffic director. The director will guide you across track.
2. You may pit anywhere you want, as long as it is on one of the "concrete pit pads or pit stalls". Someone will help you get parked.
3. You may bring your car into the pits even if you are not racing. Just park your car in the in the north eastern portion of the pit area. That section is located behind the big hill (Behind the Small Race Track – on your right) when you are entering the infield.
4. We will call you on to the track through our Public Address System. Enter the track in turn 3 of the large oval track (By the Fox 25 and Dahlauto.com Billboards), and stage yourself in one of the three lanes located in turns 3 and 4 of the oval track. The Speedway traffic director will guide you into the staging lanes.

DON'T FORGET:

1. In the drag strip area you must stay behind the walls.
2. No Carry-In's. Alcohol is not permitted in pits.
3. Have fun and be aware for your own safety at all times.
4. The Go-Karts are racing tonight, and are pitting outside our track entrance. **Please Drive Slowly**, as there are many children in this area.

IF YOU ARE DRAG RACING:

1. No Burnouts! Please sign up for the burnout contest at the pit gate if you wish to do burnouts.
2. Riders are welcome. EVERYONE must have a seat belt on.
3. No one under age 12 may ride in any drag race at any time.
4. There is no limit on practice runs (as time permits). Just pull up to the line. We will release you...one car at a time. Enter the track in turn 3 of the large oval track (By the Fox 25 and Dahlauto.com Billboards), and stage yourself in one of the three lanes located in turns 3 and 4 of the oval track. The Speedway traffic director will guide you into the staging lanes.
5. No speeding after drag runs.
6. If we determine you have “red lighted” you will be notified on the backstretch.
7. You MAY enter in more than one bracket. However, you must “move up” to a stronger bracket. Once you win the Bracket- you may not participate in that bracket for the next event. (Except for the Open Bracket).
8. When bracket racing begins, we will separate you into your “bracket”. We may combine brackets, depending on the number of vehicles entered. The brackets are run in that respective order as well. After each of *your* bracket run, you must stop on the backstretch. An Official will guide you on where to go. If you are eliminated from your bracket, you must go into the pits. We may split a Bracket if we have a large number of cars. You will have to remain on track until other “split” cars have finished. Weather and time permitting.
9. CYCLES – Insurance requires helmets & long sleeve clothing. You drag to the WHITE line.
10. Cars & Trucks Race to the ORANGE line.
11. BUYBACKS. If you are eliminated in brackets, and there is still *time permitting*, you may re-enter in the “Buyback” bracket. This will cost \$5 to enter and it is a single elimination bracket. You can purchase your Buyback on the road in turn three...it is the road that leads out onto the track.
12. Be aware that we will not tolerate stupidity. This means while racing, in the pits, or at any other time.
13. Any persons, whom have consumed alcohol prior or during the event, may not participate and may be subject to removal from the pit area.

SHINE AND SHOW / dB drags / BURNOUT CONTEST:

You may participate in all: Drag, Shine and Show, and Burnout Contest.

Burnout Contest: We will run the Burnout Contest at the beginning of all events. Sign up on your way in at the Pit Gate Registration Building. The Burnout Contest will take place after practice runs and the National Anthem have concluded, and just prior to starting the bracket runs, around 7:20. Contestants will line up on the inside lane of the frontstretch.

Shine and Show: We will do the Shine and Show around 8:15. Park your car in the shine and show area (Back up diagonally to the quarter mile backstretch wall) and

turn your flashers on. Our judges will be around to check your ride out. For dB drags, Please do the same.

TENTATIVE SCHEDULE:

6:00 - Pit Opens * **6:40** - Practice/Grudge runs *
7:30 - Brackets (see below for order) * **7:50** Burnout Contest *
8:15 – dB drags / Shine & Show

BRACKET ORDER AND DEFINITIONS

Open - Any vehicle with open exhaust and/or slicks. (No cooling between runs).

Cycles - Any type of motorcycle. Helmet and long sleeve pants and jacket Required. (Finish line is white line)

Mustangs - OEM and Performance. (You may enter Detroit Iron bracket also)

Burn out - (tentative) Best 60 second burn. Fans decide who wins.

Trucks - OEM and Performance. Must be in two wheel drive only.

Detroit Iron - OEM and Performance.

Domestic - OEM and Limited Performance.

Tuners - OEM and Performance. No 4WD.

4 WD -OEM and Performance. Trucks and Cars.

NOTE: OEM MEANS "ORIGINAL EQUIPMENT from MANUFACTURER)

REMEMBER YOU MAY "Buy Back"- Any one that loses in their bracket may buy back into the bracket. However, Buy Backs are single eliminations and must be purchased on back stretch as long as time permits.
